**ENGINEER'S REPORT:**

Mr. Bright reported that the Member's First sewer extension work has been completed thru Weaver's parking lot and along the east side of Aspen Avenue. Laterals have been installed at the first two houses along Aspen Avenue and as soon as the line is operational letters are to be sent to those two residents letting them know they can connect. They will be given the same choice as the Walter's Avenue residents; hook up now or when the property is sold or when their on site system fails.

Mr. Bright reported that the authority received a Sewage Facility Planning exemption document for Lot 1 which is next to where Member's First Credit Union will be. They are proposing a coffee shop and 3 office spaces. Mr. Bright asked for a motion for the Chairman to sign the Sewage Facility Planning exemption document for the proposed coffee shop/offices.

**ON A MOTION** by Mr. Musante and seconded by Mr. Schultz, it was unanimously voted to have Mr. Gerhart, as Chairman, sign the Sewage Facility Planning Exemption document.
